The Paschal Candle moves beside the altar during the Easter season. This large, white candle is an ancient symbol for Christ, the light of the world. The candle contains a cross and/or an Alpha Omega to symbolize that Jesus is eternal and always present with his people. **White** is the traditional color for this season, which celebrates Christ's resurrection. The butterfly symbolizes resurrection, Easter and the new life we have in Christ Jesus.

You are always invited to: Light a candle, say a prayer at the altar... in memory, in celebration, in thanksgiving. *Candles will remain lit until they have burned out safely into the sand*.
