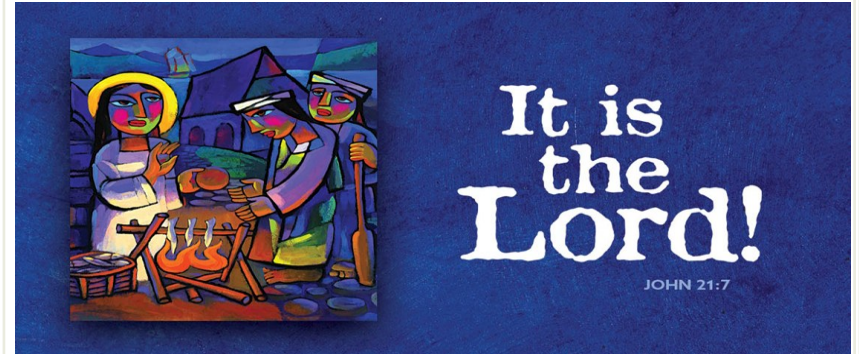

The Paschal Candle moves beside the altar during the Easter season. This large, white candle is an ancient symbol for Christ, the light of the world. The candle contains a cross and/or an Alpha Omega to symbolize that Jesus is eternal and always present with his people. The butterfly symbolizes resurrection, Easter and the new life we have in Christ Jesus.
