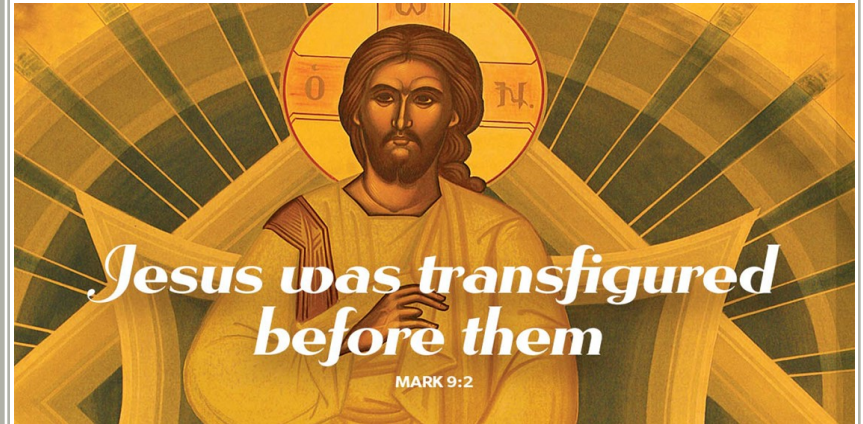

ASH WEDNESDAY...

Ash Wednesday confronts us with our limits as human beings - our sinfulness, mortality, vulnerability. "You are dust, and to dust you shall return," is said as the ashes are traced on your forehead. The cross reminds us of who we are, and more importantly, whose we are. This marking includes an invitation to reflect on moments when we have been woken up to deeper truths about ourselves. The "disciplines of Lent - self-examination and repentance, prayer and fasting, sacrificial giving and works of love" are encouraged.
